Australia To be listed, sunscreens must comply with the Australian and New Zealand Sunscreen Standard AS/NZS 2604 Sunscreen products—Evaluation and classification in force at the time of listing A new Australian and New Zealand Sunscreen Standard, AS/NZS 2604:2012 which replaces the previous Standard AS/NZS 2604:1998
